**Bat White Nose Syndrome**

Daniel Gammons, wildlife biologist for Sequoia National Park, will describe White Nose Syndrome in North American bats and the role of the National Park Service in researching and combating the spread of the disease.

Saturday we will leave from the Sears parking lot in Visalia at 7:30 AM. Second meeting spot at Bravo Lake Botanical Garden in Woodlake at 8:00 AM. Starting in Woodlake we will travel from the valley floor and follow the winding road up Dry Creek through foothill chaparral to the mixed woods of Eshom Valley or Drumm Valley depending on where conditions are the best. This can be a wonderful spring wildflower trip combined with birding. Due to the varied habitats we will see waterfowl, owl, various hawk, Neotropics like Lazuli Bunting and Bullock's Oriole, elusive Wrentit, and California Thrasher.
